

RALLYE DEFINITIONS AND ABBREVIATIONS

1. **RIGHT or LEFT** A turn or deviation of approximately 90 degrees.
2. **BEAR** A turn or deviation of noticeably less than 90 degrees
3. **ACUTE** A turn or deviation of noticeably more than 90 degrees.
4. **T** An intersection where a road terminates approximately perpendicular to another road. An intersection may be considered a “T” only when approached from the terminating road.
5. **Y** An intersection forming the general shape of a “Y” as approached from the base
6. **INTERSECTION** Any meeting of existing roads from which the Rallye vehicle could proceed in more that one direction without making a U-turn.
7. **DELTA** A triangular-shaped plot at an intersection
8. **COL** Clue On Left . The sign or clue is on the left side of the road. If “COL” is not indicated, the clue must be on your right or straight ahead.
9. **STOP** Stop Sign erected by local traffic authority. Hexagonal shape, red background, white lettering: STOP
10. **ONTO** Designation to remain on the named road or route number until explicitly instructed to deviate from the named road or route number
11. **SR** State Route
12. **US** United States Route
13. **I** Interstate Route
14. **HTS** Hard To See. The Rallyemaster wants to let you know that this clue may be more difficult to see than the others are.
15. **OCC** On Course Clue. Used to indicate that you are traveling along the proper route. No change of direction is to be made at an On Course Clue.
16. **CAST** Change Average Speed To ...
17. **JOG RIGHT OR JOG LEFT** Two consecutively executed turns in opposite directions.
Eg.: JOG RIGHT means turn right, then turn left at the earliest opportunity.
JOG LEFT means turn left, then turn right at the earliest opportunity.
